2nd Colloquium for the presentation of feminist papers

Every semester, students and young academics write term papers, research reports, protocols, essays, theses, dissertations and other exciting scientific papers. However, these are rarely read except by the respective supervisors or, at most, by friends. We think this is a great pity! In order to give these lost treasures a new home, we as the feminist platform (fe_marburg) would like to invite you to a colloquium.

The colloquium for the presentation of feminist papers will take place on Thursday, December 02 and on Thursday, December 09 via BigBlueButton, both from 18:00 to 20:00.¹ This colloquium is intended to provide a space for students and early career scholars to share work, give each other feedback, and continue to encourage thinking outside the box. So, gather your work from your hard drives, CDs, and floppy disks and join us for our colloquium!

Contributions should be designed for a presentation time of max. 20 min. followed by a discussion. Contributions can be submitted and held in German as well as in English. Please submit only one contribution per person(/group). Interested parties are invited to send the documents in PDF format to kontakt@femarburg.de by 15.11.2021.

Please submit the following three documents as individual PDF files:

- concept paper (short summary of the planned contribution with information on the title, subject matter, objectives, theory(s) and/or method(s) (max. 3000 characters).
- short summary of the contribution for the promotional brochure (max. 500 characters)
- completed form (see information on the author of the contribution)

Please make sure that your concept paper does not contain any references to your person, name or photos. Personal information should only be included in the application form. We will first review the concept papers and include information about life circumstances in the second selection step to ensure that people with different social positioning get a voice.

For the selection of the contribution, we ask to consider the following criteria:

The paper must encompass

- gender and/or
- sexuality and/or
- feminist approaches or perspectives.

In addition, the contribution should

- be interdisciplinary, or
- present a critical reflection of a research approach, or
- reveal negotiation processes of social relations of power.

Contributions from outside the humanities are very welcome. In the selection process, we want to consider the distribution across as many disciplines as possible.
